- 1. What are the basic teachings and titles of the Catholic Church about Mary (often Marion feasts) which are sometimes questioned by non-Catholics?
- 2. What is the Gospel ("good news") of salvation? Is it just about our getting into heaven (pp. 14-15)? What does this have to do with Mary (p. 16)?
- 3. According to the Hebrew language, what did it mean that Adam and Eve were created "very good"(pp. 17-18)? What other gift do they receive? What is Eve called before the fall?
- 4. Through the "Fall" (the act of disobedience to God), what gifts do Adam and Eve lose, and what sufferings do they bring upon themselves (pp. 19-20)?
- 5. How is Genesis 3:15 seen as the "First Gospel" (Protoevangelium) (pp. 21-24)?
- 6. Mary appears only twice in the Gospel of John. When are these episodes, and what "title" is given her in both Scriptures? How does this relate to Genesis 3:15? (See chart p. 29).
- 7. In Revelation 12:1-13, who is the "woman clothed with the sun" (pp. 31-33)?
- 8. Is there evidence that ancient Christians saw Mary as the "new Eve"? How does this lead us to the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception (pp. 33-39)? Where is the doctrine addressed in the CCC (p. 38)? Which Pope formally declared the Immaculate Conception as doctrine?
